



Volunteer Photographer

Travel throughout the county to capture photographs of clients sharing their stories of how hunger affects their lives.

IMPACT

Currently more than 400,000 individuals in San Diego County are food insecure, or 1 in 8 people. These are often hard working adults, children and seniors who cannot make ends meet and may go without food for several meals, days or extended periods of time. The Volunteer Photographer will capture images that reflect our mission and help spread awareness of the effect hunger plays in our community.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The Volunteer Photographer will assist the Marketing & Communication Manager. Images would be used for FSD marketing collateral, including social media, website, donor communication and more. This will include:

- Travel to food distributions throughout the county
- Photograph clients sharing their testimonials with FSD staff
- Collect photo release forms from clients

TIME COMMITMENT

This volunteer would visit 1-2 events monthly, with flexible scheduling. Volunteer would need to be available daytime, between Monday-Friday, to capture photographs of clients. Otherwise volunteer would capture photographs at special events and volunteer functions if only available during evenings and weekends.

KEY SKILLS AND ABILITIES

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. - You have a passion for hunger relief and want to make a difference
- You are a professional photographer or are a serious hobbyist
- You have your own photography and computer supplies
- You believe in our values, including respect, integrity, and diversity
- You are able to work in a variety of settings with culturally-diverse families and communities with the ability to be culturally sensitive and appropriate

LICENSES/CERTIFICATIONS

Must have reliable transportation and possess and maintain a valid driver's license, a satisfactory driving record, including proof of personal vehicle insurance coverage and insurability under the Agency's insurance carrier standards.

TRAINING PROVIDED

Volunteer Orientation will provide volunteers with an understanding of Feeding San Diego as a whole before role specific training. Additional training provided will include:

- Role specific training with Marketing & Communications Manager
- FSD brand and style guide training
- Opportunity to shadow staff beginning your service
