**FEEDING SAN DIEGO TO FEED HUNGRY CHILDREN THIS SUMMER  
AT 15 SITES ACROSS SAN DIEGO COUNTY**

*Summer Lunch Sites are Free to Children Struggling with Hunger*

**San Diego, CA — May 31, 2018** — [Feeding San Diego](#) announces 15 distribution sites for the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), a critical part of its [Fuel for Summer](#) campaign. This program provides critical support throughout the summer to ensure that kids are getting the nutrition they need to live healthy and productive lives.

In San Diego County, 1 in 6 children face hunger. That’s over 127,000 food insecure youth, many of whom lose access to vital school meals over the long summer months. Feeding San Diego is working to fill that meal gap by offering these free summer meals and snacks to any children between 1 and 18 who participate. There are no forms to fill out.

  - **East:** *Naranca Elementary*, June 27<sup>th</sup>, July 18<sup>th</sup>, August 8<sup>th</sup> 9:00 AM-10:00 AM
