


# **Volunteer Driver**

## **POSITION DESCRIPTION**

Support Nativity Prep Academy's food rescue operations by picking up and delivering food donations.

### **IMPACT**

Nearly 35% of food produced in the United States is wasted. Feeding San Diego collaborates with over 100 community partners to help rescue edible food that would otherwise go to waste.



### **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Volunteer Driver will assist Feeding San Diego by picking up food donations from Albertsons and delivering them to Nativity prep Academy. This will include:

- You must have proof of license and perform pickups in the one of the following ways:
  - 1. With personal, and reliable, transportation
  - 2. With a Feeding San Diego van (additional clearance required)
  - 3. With Nativity Prep Academy's vehicle (background check and additional clearance required)
- Loading, unloading, and monitoring food donation
- Exercise both food safety and personal safety in every step of the pick-up and delivery process
- Communicate with all relevant parties in a timely manner
- Documenting food temperatures

## TIME COMMITMENT

The Volunteer Driver would support a minimum of one recurring pick-up a week. Pick-up takes place weekly on Mondays between 7AM – 9AM. Each pick-up takes approximately 2 hours to complete (including driving time). We ask for a minimum 3-month commitment.

# **KEY SKILLS AND ABILITIES**

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty. The requirements below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to allow all individuals to perform essential functions.

- You have a positive attitude and provide excellent customer service
- You are comfortable lifting up to 50 lbs for over 30 minutes (loading and unloading food).



## **ADDITIONAL TRAINING**

This position will require some additional training (see below). This training will be provided by trained Feeding San Diego staff:

- Volunteer Driver Orientation and Training (1.5 2 hours)
- Food Handler Training: Prior Food Handler Card Accepted if received/renewed within the past 2 years. Training offered (no-cost to volunteer) by Feeding San Diego (2 - 3 hours)
- FSD Van Driving (optional): volunteer drivers may have the opportunity to use FSD vans to conduct donation pick-ups and deliveries. Additional qualifications needed.
