


Alpine Produce Pantry Support

POSITION DESCRIPTION

Support Feeding San Diego's Direct Services team by assisting with post-distribution logistics at our Alpine Produce Pantry. This role focuses on pallet recovery, heavy lifting support, and transportation after food distributions, ensuring the site can safely and efficiently close out service for the day.

IMPACT

Feeding San Diego provides more than 31 million meals each year to people facing hunger across San Diego County. Produce Pantry distributions are a critical part of that work.



As a Direct Service Distribution Support Volunteer, you help ensure that pantry volunteers, many of whom are not physically able to manage heavy lifting, can continue serving neighbors with dignity, safety, and care.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The Direct Service Distribution Support Volunteer will assist Feeding San Diego staff and pantry volunteers with post-distribution logistics. This includes:

- Retrieve a Feeding San Diego van from the warehouse
- Drive the van to Produce Pantry: Alpine (1912 Arnold Way, Alpine, CA 91901)
- Assist with heavy lifting during site close-out, including:
 - Loading empty pallets into the van
 - Supporting volunteers with physical tasks as needed
 - Assisting with consolidation of cardboard and compost
- Transport pallets back to Feeding San Diego
- Unload and neatly stack pallets in the designated yard area

TIME COMMITMENT

- Two shifts per month
- Schedule: 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of each month
- Time: 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM



KEY SKILLS AND ABILITIES

To perform this role successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty. The requirements below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

- Comfortable performing repetitive lifting and physical tasks
- Ability to safely lift and move pallets with a team
- Valid driver's license and comfort driving a cargo van
- Reliable, punctual, and able to commit to a recurring schedule
- Ability to follow safety guidelines and staff direction
