

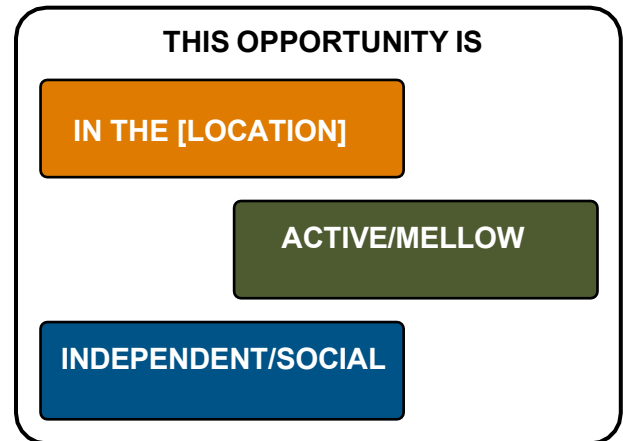
Volunteer Videographer

POSITION DESCRIPTION

Support Feeding San Diego's Neighborhood Partnerships team by providing video recording and editing support for partner-facing events and materials. This role focuses on creating professional, on-brand video content for the Annual Summit and ongoing partner trainings, helping ensure our work is clearly communicated and effectively represented.

IMPACT

Feeding San Diego provides more than **31 million meals each year** to people facing hunger across San Diego County. Strong partnerships are a critical part of sustaining that work.



As a Volunteer Videographer, you help ensure partners, funders, and stakeholders understand the impact of Feeding San Diego's programs through clear, engaging video content.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

As a Volunteer Videographer, you will support the Neighborhood Partnerships team with the planning, creation, and editing of video content. Responsibilities include:

- Record video content at select events or scheduled recording sessions (e.g., Annual Summit, testimonials)
- Edit video footage into short-form and long-form content, including sizzle reels, recap videos, and training materials
- Collaborate with staff to understand goals, audience, and messaging for each video
- Apply Feeding San Diego brand guidelines to all video content
- Support periodic updates to partner-facing training videos as needed

TIME COMMITMENT

The time commitment for this role is project-based and varies depending on the timing and scope of each video request.

- Ongoing, project-based commitment (approximately 7 months)
- Work is intermittent and tied to specific projects or events
- Some in-person availability required for recordings; editing may be completed remotely
- Schedule and deadlines will vary depending on project scope



KEY SKILLS AND ABILITIES

To perform this role successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty. The requirements below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

- Must have your own equipment
- Previous experience with video recording and editing
- Ability to learn and apply organizational branding and tone
- Comfort working independently and managing project-based timelines
- Strong communication skills and responsiveness
- Access to personal recording or editing equipment is a plus

Reasonable accommodation may be provided to allow all individuals to perform essential functions.

- Completion of required confidentiality agreements (NDAs)
