POSITION DESCRIPTION

Support preschool and kindergarten families by helping operate Feeding San Diego's School Pantry distributions in partnership with Clothier Child Development Center in Escondido.

Volunteers are asked to commit to supporting recurring distributions for a minimum of 6 months on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays of each month at either

- 7:30 a.m. – 10:30 a.m.
- 1:30 p.m. – 5:30 p.m.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The Recurring School Pantry Volunteer will assist the Direct Services team by making a commitment to regularly support Clothier Child Development Centers School Pantry distribution two times per month. Responsibilities include:

- Helping receive and organize food for distribution.
- Setting up food tables and designated distribution areas.
- Assisting with food distribution to participating families.
- Maintaining a clean, organized, and safe distribution site.
- Adhering to all personnel safety and food safety policies.
- Communicating expected absences to Feeding San Diego staff in advance, as needed.

KEY SKILLS AND ABILITIES

To perform this role successfully, volunteers should relate to the following:

- You have a passion for hunger relief and want to make a difference.
- You know that working together as a team is the best way to solve hunger.
- You would rather help while on your feet in the warehouse versus at a desk in an office.
- You know that safety comes first, and will follow all FSD safety and food safety policies.
- You believe in our values, including respect, integrity, and diversity.
- You are able to interact with individuals of various backgrounds and ages.

PARTNER SITE REQUIREMENT

Volunteers must be able to provide documentation of current immunization records if requested by the partner site for licensing or audit purposes.
